



Biomedical Research Alliance of New York (BRANY)
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- BRANY is the largest alliance of clinical trial research sites in the United States including over 200 affiliates, providing research support services to sponsors and investigators involved with clinical trials in all therapeutic areas.
- Staffed by multi-disciplinary experts, BRANY is an “expedited, end-to-end solution” for clinical trials. Services include:
 - Site identification, initiation, and support
 - Singular point of contact
 - Contract and budget negotiations
 - Informed consent preparation
 - IRB submissions
 - Administrative support of regulatory documents
 - Central IRB
 - Bi-weekly Meetings
 - Expedited reviews of qualifying documents
 - Institutional Biosafety Committee services (for recombinant DNA/gene transfer research)

 - On-site GCP review (as an extension of the IRB)
 - New investigators audited for GCP, IRB and regulatory compliance

- BRANY Institute for Research Education offers in-person training to advance the field of clinical research. Courses include:
